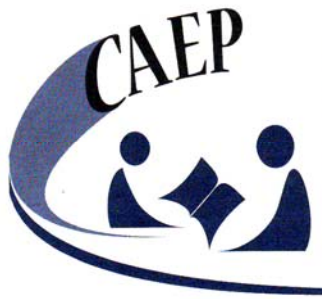

- September 9, 2009: Regular Registration Deadline for SAT & Subject Tests. The date for this test is: October 10, 2009.

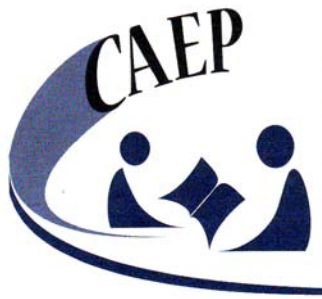
